



## **Species at Risk Stewardship Program Objectives**

A project may be funded if it promotes one or more of the following objectives:

- Improves the well-being of species of concern;
- Takes protective measures for species' habitats or ecosystems;
- Encourages involvement in stewardship activities through outreach, education and awareness-building; or
- Increases stewardship-related knowledge and skills of landowners or other groups.

#### Which Species are Eligible?

Projects must focus on species that are:

- Native to the NWT; and
- Of conservation concern in the NWT.

- Co-management Boards;

- Individuals.

#### How will Applications be Reviewed?

Applications will be evaluated using a standard set of evaluation criteria. Proposals must:

- Be completed in full;
- Demonstrate eligibility;
- Clearly show how the project will meet any of the program objectives; and
- Be well-planned and feasible.

### **Reporting Requirements**


Successful applicants must submit a project summary report.

#### **How Much Funding is Available?**

The maximum available for any project is \$5,000 per year.

Funding will be evenly distributed between NWT regions based on the administrative regions:

- Inuvik region
- Sahtu region
- South Slave region
- Deh Cho region
- Yellowknife
- North Slave region, excluding Yellowknife
