PRIVATE SALE OF NWT FURS

Did you know that you can sell your pelts to a licensed fur dealer or private citizen and still be eligible for Prime Fur Bonus and grubstake?

Step by Step Instructions!

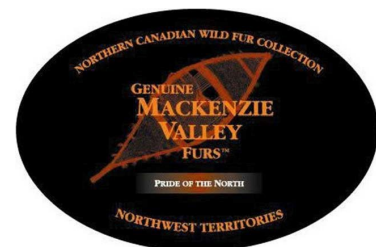
To qualify, the value of the sale **MUST** be equal to or greater than the advance amount for that species.

- Harvesters must provide a copy of the transaction (*i.e. proof of sale*).
 - A template can be provided by ECC if requested.
- The proof of sale needs to include:
 - Date of sale
 - Value of the sale*
 - The signature the seller
 - The signature of the buyer
- Transactions are traceable to ensure they are bought/ sold only once in the GMVFP.
- Transactions must be verified by an ECC issuing officer or a recognized designate.

ALL SALES MUST BE TRANSPARENT

If a private sale is not transparent then the fur should not be part of the GMVP.

Private sales between immediate family members are **NOT** eligible for benefits under the GMVF Program.
