### **Approval Decision of DDMI Tier 3 Wildlife Management and Monitoring Plan Amendment (W2015L2-0001)**

---

On September 06, 2024, Diavik Diamond Mines Inc. (DDMI) submitted an amendment request for the approved Tier 3 Wildlife Management and Monitoring Plan (WMMP) to have the Zone of Influence (ZOI) analysis removed as a condition.

The proposed WMMP amendment underwent public review on the Online Review System beginning on February 07, 2025. Tłıchǫ Government, Environmental Monitoring Advisory Board (EMAB), Department of Fisheries and Oceans (DFO), and Environment and Climate Change Canada (ECCC) provided comments.

Upon consideration of the review comments, the Government of Northwest Territories Environment and Climate Change's (GNWT-ECC) approves the amendment of the Tier 3 WMMP, removing the ZOI analysis. Instead, DDMI will continue with caribou collar movement analysis to determine if behaviour changes with distance to mine.

GNWT-ECC thanks Tłıchǫ Government, EMAB, DFO, ECCC and DDMI for their time and engagement.
