Re: April 23, 2025 - Status of Approval Conditions for the Wildlife Management and Monitoring Plan (WMMP) for Digaa Enterprises Ltd. Timber Harvesting

This letter is to submit an amended Wildlife Management and Monitoring Plan prepared by Digaa Enterprises Ltd. (Digaa). Our letter is intended to address the one (1) remaining approval condition, outlined in the April 23, 2025 letter; namely:

Approval of Condition #1:

Digaa shall add an appendix to the WMMP that describes a procedure for using regularly updated boreal caribou collar location maps provided by ECC to trigger mitigation measures such as delayed start-up of project activities or suspension of activities when current collared boreal caribou overlap with pre-defined cautionary zones around areas of active timber harvesting operations. As part of this procedure, Digaa will need to update ECC on a regular basis about where operations are currently occurring or planned to occur.

ECC April 23, 2025 edits regarding Condition 1:

- This condition was partially addressed.
- To satisfy this Approval Condition, ECC requires Digaa to amend the WMMP further, adding a row to Table 1 within Appendix 3 – Caribou Monitoring Procedure to add mitigations during the calving/post-calving period.

The changes in Digaa's amended Wildlife Management and Monitoring Plan are a Deletion to the *APPENDIX 3 - Caribou Monitoring Procedure*, as follows:

Deletion:

'Although there may be occasional operations during snow free months, such as those that are immediately adjacent to existing Highway No. 1 or Highway No. 3 infrastructure'

This Deletion removes the need to amend the WMMP to address the calving and post calving season.

Digaa believes its amended WMMP meets the conditions outlined by your Office.
