



Intergovernmental Meeting between Déline Got'ine Government and Government of the Northwest Territories

Déline, NT (June 6, 2023) – Premier Caroline Cochrane, Minister Diane Archie, Minister R.J. Simpson, Minister Julie Green, Minister Paulie Chinna, and Minister Caroline Wawzonek met with the Déline Got'ine Government ?ekw'ahtidé Danny Gaudet, ?ekw'ahti Raymond Taneton Déline K'aowedó Ke members, Leonard Kenny, Christopher Yukon, Gina Dolphus, Jonas Modeste, Dora Blondin and Walter Bezha Elders Representative on Tuesday, June 6, 2023.

The meeting focused on areas of mutual interest, including:

- working to address the health needs and communication of current public health issues;
- working together on initiatives designed to improve educational outcomes in the community, including supporting teachers;
- working together to discuss expanding tourism opportunities in the community;
 and
- continuing to explore infrastructure options for winter road access to Déline and the Déline airport runway.

This was the third meeting of the two governments and continues to build on the strong relationship by collaborating and address key issues of impacting Déline residents.

- The Intergovernmental Memorandum of Understanding recognizes the importance of the government-to-government relationship between the Déline Got'ine Government and the Government of the Northwest Territories.
- The agreement commits both governments to meet at least once per year.
- The Intergovernmental Memorandum of Understanding between the Dél_ine Got'_ine Government and the Government of the Northwest Territories was signed in June 2019 for a four-year term.
