

Fred Henne Loop D

The formal construction of Fred Henne's new "D" Loop began at the close of the 2014 camping season with the cutting and removal of brush and trees along the surveyed route. A winter-long gravel haul and the creation of road infrastructure and activity pads culminated this spring with the installation of full 30 amp power service and the assembly of picnic tables and fire pits, etc. by summer parks staff.

With over 3,500 visits each week during the height of our summer, Yellowknife's Fred Henne campground is a popular destination for visitors and residents alike. The facility operates at full capacity just about every weekend during peak season.

The completion of 13 new large-recreational vehicle sites increases the capacity of the Fred Henne campground to a combined 117 campsites. The addition of the fourth loop will enable the campground to cater to approximately 5,000 additional bookings per season. The Park's camping facilities are complemented by a beach, boat launch and the Prospector hiking trail - in addition to day use areas and two group-rental kitchen facilities.
