

## **Backgrounder**

## **Stanton Renewal Project by the Numbers**

\$300 million: Value of the construction contract with Boreal Health Partnership

**\$350 million:** Total capital cost of the construction project including costs incurred by the Government of the Northwest Territories. The \$50 million in extra costs will pay for:

- o clinical information system
- o FF&E
- o project management
- o engineering
- o financial advisors
- o lawyers
- o honoraria to the unsuccessful proponents

\$751 million: Value of contract with Boreal Health Partnership (BHP).

**\$70 million:** Amount identified by BHP as available for local contractors to benefit from the project, both in construction phase and maintenance post-construction.

**\$1.1 billion:** Cost of a traditional design and build for a new Stanton Territorial Hospital, including 30 years of operation and maintenance.

**25 percent:** Approximate savings to GNWT through P3 process over traditional design and build option, approximately \$290 million.

**2015:** Construction will begin in Fall 2015.

**2018:** Construction is expected to be completed in late-2018.

**2021:** Expected year the new Stanton Territorial Hospital will be fully operational.

100: Number of beds in the new Stanton Territorial Hospital

**280,000:** Total size (square-foot) of new building, approximately double the size of the current facility.
